



GREAT WINE STARTS WITH GREAT SOIL

Our Rutherford property lies between the Napa River and Conn Creek. Over the millennium, those waterways have snaked through this property and left gravel deposits, as well as more sedimentary, richer soils towards the Napa River. Variations in the soil lead to a wide array of subtle grape qualities that all come together to produce wines of great distinction.



OUR JANNINE BOVET RESERVE & ESTATE SAUVIGNON BLANC

From the sedimentary, richer soils located on the west side of our Rutherford estate vineyards, these loose, alluvial soils derived from the volcanic Vaca Mountains contribute to the vibrant and rich palette of flavors of these wines.

OUR LOUIS BOVET RESERVE & ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

On the east side of our estate vineyards, this gravel laden soil induces a higher level of stress in the vines which produces a more intense, full bodied wine - known as our Estate and Louis Bovet Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon.
